# 1. Organizing Awareness and Educational Seminars and conferences in the college:

- **Drought-Resistant Plants:** Replacing traditional lawns in the house of the students and teachers with native, drought-resistant plants that require less water and maintenance.
- **Smart Irrigation Systems:** Promoting students, who belongs to farmer community, to install systems that water plants only when necessary, based on weather forecasts or soil moisture levels.
- **Rainwater Harvesting:** Promoting students and staffs to collect rainwater from roofs to irrigate landscaping, reducing the need for potable water.

#### 3. Water Recycling and Reuse

• **Greywater Systems:** Promoting students and staffs to use treated water from showers, sinks, and washing machines for landscape irrigation or other non-potable uses.

• **Recycling Stations:** Promoting students and staffs to set up systems that allow the reuse of water for specific applications, such as cleaning outdoor spaces or flushing toilets, Distilled Water.

By fostering a culture of water conservation, the college has lead by example in the fight against water scarcity, helping to ensure a sustainable future for students and the larger community.
